



### Visiting Assistant Professor of Economics

**George Fox University** announces a 1-year visiting non-tenure-track faculty position in Economics, to begin August 2020. It is primarily focused on our undergraduate economics program, although there may be opportunities to teach in our graduate level business and economics courses as well. As such, we seek applicants with the ability to teach in a broad range of courses, giving priority to candidates with expertise in one or more of the following areas: microeconomics, macroeconomics, international economic development, and international trade and finance.

- A commitment to working with a diverse population of students is essential; demonstrated experience in this area is preferred.
- All applicants must express a personal commitment to Jesus Christ and express their Christian testimony in a local church.
