



Full-Time Faculty Position in Economics

Qualifications include:

- TWU seeks applications who are committed Christians and able to articulate the intersection of Christian faith and business, specifically related to their discipline.
- An earned doctorate, or ABD, in Economics is preferred.
- Proven teaching excellence at a post-secondary institution is essential as well as the ability to interact with students as an academic advisor and mentor.
- As a leader in global business education, TWU desires candidates who have an in-depth understanding of the global marketplace.
- Faculty at TWU are asked to live in agreement with Statement of Faith and Community Covenant (available [here](#)). Candidates should review this statement before applying.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Applicants should have expertise in and be academically qualified to teach a broad range of economics courses both at the undergraduate and graduate level.
- Engagement with professional communities.
- Model genuine Christian faith in and beyond the classroom.
- Engagement with students outside the classroom, including advising, social interaction, and informal academic and cultural settings.
- Intentionally and explicitly integrate the Christian faith with teaching and scholarship.
- Participation in the work of the university, including serving on university committees as needed.

Application Procedures

All prospective faculty are required to submit the following as part of their online application:

- A cover letter;
- A curriculum vitae;
- A verification of doctoral (or terminal) degree;
- A signed statement of Faith and Community Covenant; and,
- A document (no more than two pages) which describes how you anticipate your Christian faith would influence your teaching and scholarship if you were a faculty member at TWU.
