

Call for Papers

ACE members who are interested in presenting their work at the 2023 annual meeting of the Southern Economic Association (SEA) should contact Ngina Chiteji < nc518@nyu.edu >. The 2023 SEA conference will be held in New Orleans, Louisiana from November 18 – 20, 2023.

I am hoping to organize a Presidential session for the conference, at the invitation of the incoming SEA President. At the moment the subject area is open, but ideally this session would feature scholarship that explores connections between religion and economic activity (in the past or the present) or focuses on areas of particular interest to Christian economists.

Presidential session proposals undergo expedited review and therefore have a high likelihood of acceptance.

Interested authors should send a paper title and an abstract (1000 characters or less; or approximately 250 words), along with the author's name, affiliation, and email address to Prof. Ngina Chiteji at nc518@nyu.edu **by March 20, 2023**. (For co-authored papers, please submit the relevant information for all authors.)

Around March 28th you will be notified as to whether your paper will be included in the session proposal that I submit to the SEA.

The SEA expects to send its official notices of acceptance with instructions for registration in mid-June.
